

Theme Descriptions

Robotics: Our students will be putting their engineering minds to work in order to create their own robots. Using Mind Storm Lego Kits, our students will spend a week preparing the ultimate robots for a final robot showdown. Robotics is accessible to children of all ages, and our teacher will lead the groups through the essential rudimentary skills that they will need to create any robot.

Creative Writing: During creative writing week, students will play writing games, hone their revision and editing skills, and work through creating their own books from the first draft stage through the final bound product.

Mad Scientist-Chemistry: During chemistry week our students will discover chemistry through hands on experiments. From understanding bases and acids to learning about ph, to creating their own exploding volcanoes, the kids will find chemistry fun and informative.

Karate and Yoga: Our certified Karate and Yoga teachers will guide you through asanas and forms. Join us to find relaxation and strengthen your body!

Nature Crafts: The summer is the perfect time to get outside and observe nature. Our students will not only observe, but they will also use their observations to create works of art. The final products will include nature-inspired art, as well as works composed of sticks, berries, rocks, leaves and more. Come and see what the kids create at our end-of-the-week art show!

Going Green: Our students at Springboard are always talking about Going Green. During this week, our teachers will lead students through basic ways to make their worlds more environmentally friendly. They will start a garden, create eco-friendly bumper stickers, build posters to inform the community and hold a gathering for parents and staff on the final day to inform us all about how we can help!

Outdoor Survival: What does it take to survive in the wilderness? This week will be spent with lots of time outdoors, so be sure to bring sun tan lotion, bug spray and sneakers. We will make our own fishing poles, learn how to forage for food, explore plant and insect identification, navigate using shadows and sun and much, much more.

Comics and Scrapbooking: Pictures, glue, paste, paper, scissors and your imagination, is all you will need for this week of camp. Whether you set out to make a scrapbook of your summer, or whether you want to create a comic for a family member, our teachers will guide you through everything you need to know to make it really stand out.

Beach Day and field trips: Our students will take a trip to a local beach once a week. There will also be planned field trips that will coincide with our weekly themes. Activity fees for these trips may vary.
